## Bumpers College Honors Program 2019-2020

Graduation with Honors Distinction from Bumpers College requires each student must complete 15 credit hours of honors credits. These credits include 9 to 12 credit hours of Honors coursework and 3 to 6 credit hours of AFLS 400vH thesis hours. The thesis hours culminate in a written research or creative document outlining the student's honors project. Students are encouraged to complete honors courses within Bumpers College as well as from any other area on campus. Transfer honors courses will not be accepted toward the student's honors program requirements.

Students are encouraged to complete 6 hours of Honors credit during their freshman year. This can qualify students for research and international program funding from the Honors College.

Required and Choice of Honors Credits must total 9 to 12 hours.
