- Dean's push to increase recruitment and success of honors students
 - A priority is to increase recruitment by the Dean and Chancellor, which is currently around 11% in Bumpers College; however the graduation rate is lower at around 8% of students. Thus, the committee discussed the importance of retention with our students should be the goal.
- How do we recruit current and future honors eligible students into Honors program?
 - We should be doing this during Advising season note those students with high GPAs and recruit them, if possible.
- What is the right size for Bumpers Honors?
 - Currently at 11%; however the graduate rate is lower at 8% of students. Thus, the committee discussed the importance of retention with our students should be a goal.
- Are our eligibility requirements correct for Bumpers Honors?
 - This was discussed in previous years, and the committee agreed again that our requirements are adequate.
- Latin designation for graduation---should it only be for Honors students?
 - We are the only college who does not allow non-Honors students Latin designation. However, this has come up before in previous years in Faculty Council, thus it may be something to pursue again. We would like to be similar to other colleges. And Jody noted that non-Honors students (and their parents) complain every year about the lack of Latin designation.
