Bumpers College of AFLS Guidelines for Group Honors Research and Creative Projects

Students may, upon approval by their common mentor, work on a group project subject to the minimum terms outlined below.

Group Sizes

There shall be 2-3 students in a group with justification required for more than 3.

Individual Objectives

There shall be multiple project objectives and each student must be responsible for at least one unique objective.

Mentor and Student Expectations

- An expectation agreement prepared by the mentor that clearly outlines the roles and responsibilities of each student for the completion of the overall project must be in place at the beginning of the project.
- Each group project will be conducted in accordance with current college honors guidelines for research and creative projects
- Students must meet with the mentor a minimum of 2 times per semester, time to be established by the mentor

Finished Thesis

Each member of the group will complete an individual thesis in accordance with the existing Honors Creative Project and Honors Research Project Guidelines.

Group Thesis Defense

The group will present their project together at the proposal and final defense with each member responsible for their individual objectives of the project.
