Commencement in Fall is for Sp, Su, and Fa 2020 graduates, 7 students applied for fall Honors graduation; planned small ceremonies, no speakers, duration less than 1 hour; may have two ceremonies, but students may decide not to walk or defer to Sp 21.

4. Honors Student Board report – Isabel Whitehead

Virtual meetings with student board were conducted; seeking nomination for faculty mentor award; talked about ideas for virtual event planning, possibly a virtual seminar on pre-grad/pre-professional tracks and wellness topics (e.g. how to decrease stress), as well as an activity.

5. Honors College Track discussion - Isabel Whitehead

Honors College is looking to diversify pathways towards Honors graduation; focus on a path without research or creative project/thesis to address challenges due to a high student to mentor ratio, especially in ARSC. This track would be experiential learning based, requiring 12 credits from 3 of 4 categories of experiential learning (study abroad, service learning, research/creative internships);

Discussed concern that many students would choose this track over the thesis track; this may be avoided by upfront commitment to one track over another without opportunity to switch program;

Also discussed possibility to reserve Latin Honors designations for Thesis Honors students and how to recruit non-Bumpers students to conduct Honors projects under the tutelage of Bumpers College faculty mentors.
